- Refrain from lying, cheating and stealing, and understand the serious penalties for infractions.
- Strive for excellence as a student, including the faithful handing in of all homework on time, and cooperation with teachers.
- Abstain from gossip, grumbling and complaining, seeking to demonstrate a harmonious spirit and respect all students, teachers, and staff at the Academy.

I understand and accept my parent(s)' Biblical responsibility to guide me in, and provide for, my education. It is my parent(s)' desire and decision that I attend Victory Christian Academy; therefore I agree to attend and conduct myself with an attitude and spirit which will be an honor to them.

I understand and agree with the Statement of Faith and Educational Philosophy of Victory Christian Academy, and I do pledge to willingly embrace them in the coming school year.
